Notice Regarding the Change to the Effective Date of the Revision to Student  
Residence Fees

Regarding the effective date of the revision of student residence fees, the University of Tsukuba notified students on March 18th, 2026, via the “Notice Regarding the Effective Date of the Revision to Student Residence Fees” that the university would reconsider changing the effective date which was originally set for April 1st, 2026. The university has also stated that it will notify students of the details once a decision has been made.

Regarding this matter, the University of Tsukuba hereby announces that the following decision was made at the Board of Directors meeting held on March 26th, 2026.

- The revised residence fees will take effect on a date determined by the Board of Directors.

The Board of Directors will decide on the effective date at a later time.

Following this decision, the university will continue billing residents the pre-revision residence fees (the current residence fee including common service charges) until the effective date is determined.

Furthermore, the university will continue to have a dialogue with the students and explain the role and importance of student residence halls, as well as the reason for the revision. The university will also conduct a survey aimed at maintaining and improving a “safe, secure, and comfortable” living environment in the student residence halls.

#### Additional Information

The university plans to handle prepaid residence fees and other charges as follows:

- For students paying on a monthly basis: the amount will be offset against future payments.
- For students who paid for a full year: the difference will be refunded.

The university will inform students further details regarding the procedures and the timeframe at another time.
